











BRUNO TORRISI

(Lead Actor - Paolo Borsellino)

Bruno Torrisi is an Italian film actor, highly regarded in the anti-mafia crime genre. He has performed in prestigious theaters across Italy, including CTB in Brescia, Teatro di Genova, Argentina in Rome, Regio in Parma, and Teatro Stabile in Catania. On television, he is known for his roles as Ninni Cassarà in "Il capo dei capi" and as Commissioner Licata in "Squadra Antimafia" and "Rosy Abate". Torrisi portrayed Saro Montaperto in "Il Commissario Montalbano" and Mr. Cutufà in "Il giovane Montalbano". He played the role of Baron Uccello in "La stagione della caccia" and Dr. Rubino in "Boris Giuliano". He has been the protagonist of the miniseries "Paolo Borsellino" and "Paolo Borsellino - i 57 giorni", and has also appeared in "Rocco Chinnici", "Il cacciatore", "Enrico Piaggio - Un sogno italiano", and "Maria Corleone". Currently, he is among the leading actors in the Rai TV series "Màkari". In cinema, he has appeared in "Romanzo di una strage" by Marco Tullio Giordana, "L'uomo delle stelle" by Giuseppe Tornatore, "Perdutoamor" by Franco Battiato, and "Fai bei sogni" Bellocchio. His versatility and stage presence have made him a well-known and respected figure in the Italian film industry.



DEBORA SCALZO

(Director, Screenwriter, Producer)

Debora Scalzo is a successful novelist dedicated to law enforcement themes, as well as a screenwriter, producer, distributor, and film director. Her novel "Cuore Marchiato" inspired a short film selected for the David di Donatello 2023. She is one of the producers of the short film "Tieniti Tutto," chosen for the Rome Film Festival 2023. Among her upcoming film releases is the docufilm "Paolo Vive," dedicated to Judge Paolo Borsellino and starring Bruno Torrisi, with international distribution. In pre-production is the anti-mafia film "Beyond the Uniform," inspired by a true story. Scalzo serves as an international film distributor at Underground Distribution in Verona, as well as a portfolio manager for artists and founder of Underground Management. She has won prestigious national and international awards, including the 2021 Apoxiomeno Award for literature. She also authors the "Made in Italy" column for the American magazine "My New York Magazine".

Antonio Licciardello is an Italian filmmaker specializing in cinematography and aerial cinematography, as well as the CEO of Dip Studio Production. He has collaborated with Mercurio Cinematografica on the commercial "Lara – il dono delle lingue," which has garnered five million views on YouTube. Working with Level Produzioni in Sicily, he has produced commercials for Mitsubishi Motors Italia and Maserati. As a drone operator, he created the music video for Mahmood's "Klan" and other internationally renowned music videos. Licciardello has produced personal branding videos for renowned chefs and companies such as Fabbri and Molino Dalla Giovanna. He collaborated with Debora Scalzo on the commercial "The Voyage" and the short film "Cuore Marchiato." He worked as a cameraman and colorist on a short film for the Questura di Catania, and some of his aerial shots have been featured in National Geographic. He is the filmmaker and cinematographer of the documentary "Paolo Vive" starring actor Bruno Torrisi. His experience and versatility make him a prominent figure in the Italian film industry, particularly valued for the quality of his aerial shots.


