

Information on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data (General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679, Article 13)

The processing of personal data requested for user registration at the Italian Cultural Institute in New York will be based on the principles of lawfulness, fairness, and transparency to protect the fundamental rights and freedoms of natural persons.

To this end, the following information is provided:

1. The data controller is the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI) of the Italian Republic, which operates, in this specific case, through the Italian Cultural Institute in New York, 686 Park Avenue, NY 10065 – 212-879-4242, iicnewyork@esteri.it
2. For any questions or complaints, the interested party may contact the Data Protection Officer (DPO) of the MAECI (postal address: Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, Piazzale della Farnesina 1, 00135 ROME, telephone: 0039 06 36911 (switchboard), email: rpd@esteri.it; certified email: rpd@cert.esteri.it).
3. The personal data collected will be entered into a database used for the following purposes: invitations to cultural events organized by the IIC, and dissemination of cultural newsletters.
4. The processing of data entered into the database is based on consent. Refusal to provide data will prevent the data subject from accessing the service.
5. Data processing, carried out by specifically appointed personnel of the IIC (and any Data Controller), will be carried out manually, automatically, or using a combination of these methods.
6. The data provided by the data subject during registration will be processed only by the Data Controller (and the Data Controller) and will not be disclosed to third parties.

7. Every three years following registration or renewal, the Institute will ask users to electronically confirm their interest in the service and will delete the personal data of those who fail to provide such confirmation, either due to a lack of response or express refusal.
8. The data subject may request access to and rectification of their personal data. Without prejudice to the consequences for access to the service, they may also request the deletion of such data, as well as the restriction of processing or objection to its processing. In these cases, the data subject must submit a specific request to the IIC, informing the MAECI DPO for information.
9. If they believe their rights have been violated, the data subject may lodge a complaint with the MAECI DPO (and/or the DPO of the Data Controller).
